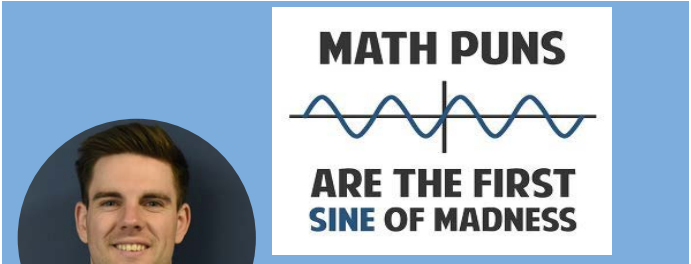
Richard Massang
